



PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING PRIVACY POLICY

Enex Srl, with registered office in Padernello di Paese (Treviso), via Veneto n. 12, tel. +39 0422 440429, email address info@enex.it, in its capacity as data controller (hereinafter referred to as the “Data Controller”), provides this notice to the Customer (hereinafter also referred as the “Data Subject”) in accordance with European and Italian regulations on personal data protection.

The Customer acknowledges that the provisions of the data protection legislation - Regulation EU 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data (hereinafter the “GDPR”) concern the processing of personal data, i.e. relating only to natural persons. For the purpose of managing the business relationship, the Data Controller will process personal data concerning (i) the Customer, if the Customer is a sole proprietor or a self-employed individual, and/or in any case (ii) the representatives, executives, employees or collaborators of the Customer's company.

Purposes of processing and legal basis

The Data Controller will process personal data to fulfil contract and regulatory obligations related to the business relationship, as well as to pursue the legitimate interest in ensuring the proper management of the relationship itself, checking the Customer's solvency status and managing any disputes. The legal basis for the processing is the need to pursue the above-mentioned purposes.

Data retention time

The Data Controller plans to process the Customer's data for the entire duration of the business relationship and, thereafter, to comply with all obligations connected with or arising therefrom, for such period as laid down by law and in accordance with the statute of limitations of the rights arising from the business relationship, without prejudice to further retention for the time necessary for the settlement (however reached) of any disputes that may arise.

Nature of the data provided and consequences arising from denial to provide the data

The provision of data is necessary and therefore any refusal to provide such data in whole or in part may make it impossible for the Data Controller to pursue the (administrative and accounting) purposes set out in the contract.

Groups of recipients

The Data Controller will not disseminate the data but plans to disclose them to internal individuals authorised to process them on the basis of their respective duties, as well as to Group companies, sales agents, credit institutions, credit insurance companies, debt collection companies, business information companies, consulting firms, business associations and/or organisations, professionals or service companies, as well as public and private bodies, including following inspections and audits. These recipients, should they process data on behalf of the Controller, will be appointed as data processors pursuant to an agreement or other legal deed.

Data transfer to a non-EU country and/or international organisation

As a rule, personal data will not be transferred either to non-European or to international organisations. The Data Controller may, however, need to make such transfers as part of its dealings with business partners established outside the European Economic Area and as a result of reliance on IT services (e.g. cloud, backup, etc.). In all such cases, transfers will be made in accordance with the specific requirements set out in the data protection regulations.



Data subject rights

The Data Subject has the right to ask the Data Controller to access his or her personal data and to rectify them if they are inaccurate, to erase them or restrict their processing to the extent as appropriate, to object to their processing for legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller, as well as to obtain the portability of the data personally provided only if they are subject to automated processing based on consent or by contract. The Data Subject also has the right to withdraw the consent given for the processing purposes that require such consent, with the understanding that this will not affect the lawfulness based on the consent given prior to such withdrawal.
